This issue (distributed at **MADE EXPO** and **SASMIL** in Milan) will analyze the timber market in Italy and the world. We will publish market data and figures (many exclusive) supplied by Itto (tropical wood), Unece-Fao (South America, Africa and South East Asia), Cei-Bois (European softwood and hardwood), Federlegno-Arredo (Italian market).

An in-depth analysis of **SAWMILLS** with a closer look at European neighbor countries will also be featured.

february

This issue will analyze the **building industry** in detail, with interviews to industry professionals at Made Expo and an extensive review of technology and materials for constructions.

The magazine will be distributed at **KLIMAHOUSE** in Bozen, a leading exhibition dedicated to bio-construction.

march

New wood species and wooden products for window manufacturers will be the key topics of this issue, distributed at **SAIESPRING** in Bologna. Interviews and technical articles by industry experts will be published, with a focus of news from the global industry.

april

The **SALONE DEL MOBILE** in Milan has always been an event not to be missed by wood professionals. This issue will focus on the relationship between **"wood and furniture"** trying to understand if this valuable material can still play a key role in the international furniture industry, with interviews to timber and veneer traders and technical articles.

A section will be dedicated to **paints** and **treatment** for outdoor wood elements (autoclave, vacuum...).

At the biennial exhibition of woodworking technology **XYLEXPO** in Milan, the magazine will feature a huge section dedicated to **technology** for primary operations and for the production of semifinished materials (matchboards, skirting boards, strips...).

For the first time, the Milan exhibition will be held concurrently with **D.I.M.A.F.** Il Legno will not miss this event, presenting the latest technological solutions available to forestry operators.

The future of **logistics** (strategies and technology) will be the key topic of this issue, that will be a journey in the world of timber and wood-based panel handling and transport (in Italy and abroad). september

october

The issue, to be distributed at **SAIE** in Bologna and at **EXPOEDILIZIA** in Rome, will feature a huge section on timber **construction technologies** (solid wood and glulam). "Case histories" of companies that use these technologies will be published (only for our advertisers).

november
december

The issue (distributed at **DOMUSLEGNO** in Rimini and the **INTERNATIONAL HOLZBAUFORUM** in Garmisch) will analyze the Italian national market with a wide section of **complementary products**: joints, outdoor paints, glulam, Bilama and Trilama, yellow panels, Kvh...).

A section will be dedicated to the market of **tropical hardwood**.
